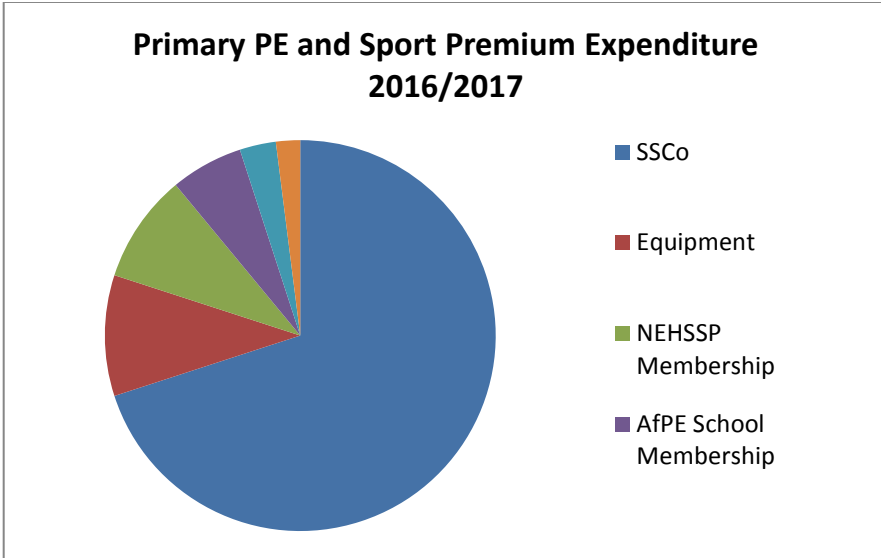


Greneway Sport Premium Overview: July 2017

Since 2013 Greneway have received £8000+£5 per pupil in KS2 per year. Totalling approximately £9000 per academic year.



The money is predominately used for one day teacher release for Rob Dowler (Greneway PE teacher). This enables him to work as an SSCo with in the North East Herts Schools Sports Partnership.

Part of this involves:

- taking Greneway teams to partnership competitions
- organising and hosting first school events
- providing additional intra school events at Greneway

Funding is to...Improve the quality of PE and School Sport provision. Indicators include:

Engagement of all pupils in regular physical activity

- In addition to the 3 hours of curriculum PE per week and 13 different sporting extra-curricular clubs. Mr Dowler SSCO provides 18 additional opportunities throughout the year. These range from Ninja Warrior to Intra school tournaments. These events are accessible to all pupils. * All pupils participate in our School Sportsdays with their PBs.

Raise the profile of PE and School Sport

- AfPE membership enables Greneway to apply for the AfPE quality mark where we achieved Distinction in 2013 and have had this re-accredited now in 2017. This has further raised the profile of PE and School Sport at Greneway, within the local community and across the county due to press releases and social media.

Broader experience of a range of sports and activities

- The NEHSSP enables Greneway to take part in 28 School Games District partnership competitions with them then providing School Games County finals for the winners. Greneway qualified for 10 County finals this academic year providing the next level of competition for 12% of our pupils.
- As part of the partnership Greneway also run festivals for the first schools in the Greneway family including Icknield Walk, Studlands Rise, Reed and St Marys. This has led to 240 year 3/4s attending the events.
- HSBC Road to Wimbledon Greneway Tennis competition with 178 pupils taking part and two representing the school in the county finals.
