



Cycling to school

A few parents have contacted us enquiring about the possibility of their children cycling to school. In the past we have not allowed this to happen unless pupils have passed their cycling proficiency. We have decided to lift this restriction but only under the following conditions:

- The bicycle must be roadworthy. (We shall do spot checks on brakes and check tyres)
- Pupils must wear a helmet
- All bicycles to be locked by the owner and left in the cycle racks by the East Door entrance
- Pupils to dismount from their bicycles at school gates and walk into school

Permission to ride to school will need to be given each year and pupils will be given a permit allowing them to have the bicycle on site for that year. If any child abuses the rules their permit will be confiscated.

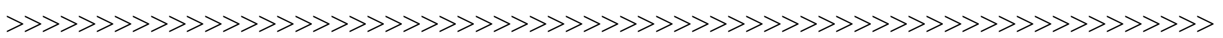
