Home-School-Pupil Agreement

As Parent(s)/Carer(s) I/we will try to:

- encourage our son/daughter to value his/her education and do our best to stimulate an enthusiasm for learning;
- see that our son/daughter goes to school every day, on time and properly dressed and equipped;
- avoid all unnecessary absences and inform the school before 9.30 am on the first day and subsequent day(s) of any absence;
- support the school's policies, the Code of Conduct on behaviour and the Anti-Bullying Code;
- check and sign the learning journal every week;
- support our son/daughter with homework and try to provide a suitable environment for this to be carried out;
- let the school know about any problems which might affect our son/daughter's work or behaviour;
- encourage our son/daughter to join lunchtime or after-school activities;
- attend open evenings and parent interviews about our son/daughter's progress.

As a school we will try to:

- provide a safe, caring and positive learning environment for your son/daughter;
- ensure that your son/daughter achieves his/her full potential as a valued, trusted and respected member of the school community;
- provide a curriculum that is rich in opportunities;
- acknowledge the effort and achievements of your son/daughter;
- promote high standards of work and behaviour through building good relationships and developing a sense of responsibility;
- set, mark and monitor homework and provide facilities for your son/daughter to do homework during the lunchtime and/or at the end of the school day;

- keep you informed about general school matters through regular editions of the Magpie and parents' information evenings;
- arrange open evenings and parent interviews during which your son/daughter's progress will be discussed;
- listen to your concerns and do our best to act upon these;
- be open and welcoming at all times and offer opportunities for you to become involved in the daily life of the school

As a pupil I will try to

- trust and respect my teachers, and other members of the school's staff, and understand that they will challenge and support me so that I achieve my best;
- do all my classwork and homework as well as I can;
- show my diary to my parent(s)/carer(s) and discuss at home what I am doing at school;
- take part in different extra-curricular clubs and activities;
- be polite, respectful and helpful to adults and other pupils in school, particularly during lessons, and on the way to and from school;
- attend school every day and arrive on time, dressed smartly in school uniform and fully equipped for the school day;
- complete my homework on time and be honest with my teachers if I find it difficult or I am unable to meet the deadline;
- respect and value the school grounds and try to keep these free from litter.
